- The **ascendancy of Islam** has increased in the last two generations. There is also a growth and threat of **radical Muslims** with ISIS and Boko Haram.
- The **church in southern Chad** needs uplifted prayer especially from deception, nominalism, tribalism, petty legalism. There is a need for **unity** and **vision** for outreach to northern Muslims.
- Training **Christlike leaders**. Leaders who will be full of character when corruption from leaders is normal.
- Of all African countries Chad has the most unreached peoples. Over 80 of 140 people groups in Chad still need the gospel.
- Youthfulness. Over 50% of Chad is **under the** age of 18.
- Lack of laborers. There is a need for **laborers** with a pioneer spirit, perseverance in language and cultural acquisition, and endurance to minister in hard places.
- Immensity of **needs**. Outreach through Bible translation, literacy, Jesus Film, storying, radio, medical care, education projects, community development, and faithful gospel witness.
